



The Microbiology Section of The Kidney Centre Laboratory actively participates in the National External Quality Assessment Program (NEQAP) to ensure the highest standards of accuracy and reliability in culture and antimicrobial susceptibility testing.

In a demonstration of this commitment, **Mr. Zain-ul-Abedin**, Laboratory Supervisor, represented the TKC Microbiology Department at the National Meeting of NEQAP Participating Laboratories at the National Institute of Health (NIH), Islamabad. The meeting focused on strengthening nationwide quality assurance practices in bacteriology. During the session, Mr. Zain-ul-Abedin received hands-on training in best practices for bacteriological testing and interpreting NEQAP performance using the Z-score scale, further enhancing our laboratory's capacity for standardized analysis and continuous quality improvement.

THE KIDNEY CENTRE'S COMPREHENSIVE VASCULAR ACCESS SERVICE REVOLUTIONIZES RENAL CARE

FEATURE ARTICLE BY DR BILAL MASOOD KHAN, CONSULTANT UROLOGIST, VASCULAR ACCESS AND TRANSPLANT SURGEON

The Kidney Centre has become a centre point for renal failure treatment. Dialysis remains the mainstay of treatment for the majority of these patients. With the state-of-the-art dialysis centre already in place, the thing missing from the armamentarium of The Kidney Centre Hospital was a vascular access service.

With most of these patients already drained financially from the burden of the disease, these procedures are offered at well-discounted welfare prices to everyone and anyone.

The requirements for the creation of an arteriovenous fistula range from a basic 45-minute procedure to more complex surgeries requiring 3 to 4-hour-long procedures. Procedures like basilic vein transposition, femoral vein transposition, translocation, and AVBG, which were not done in good numbers at other centres because of the high cost and complexity attached to them, are now being offered at The Kidney Centre Hospital.

For the troubleshooting of faults and malfunctioning of these fistulas, fistula salvage surgeries and fistula refashioning surgeries are also offered at The Kidney Centre hospital. These are essential for patients as it allows them to continue their dialysis through the fistula without needing a catheter to be put in.

Vascular access service is another feather in the cap of The Kidney Centre Hospital. I believe that increasing the spectrum of urologists to deal with access problems as well will result in creating more manpower and will help in solving the issue of this patient population.
