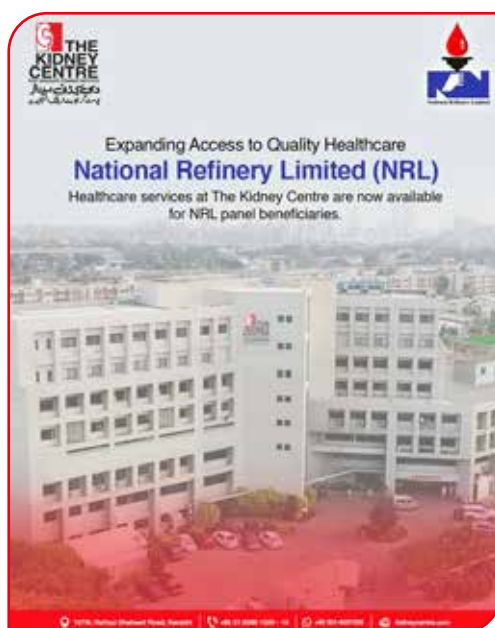
THE KIDNEY CENTRE AND IBA KARACHI SIGN A STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP

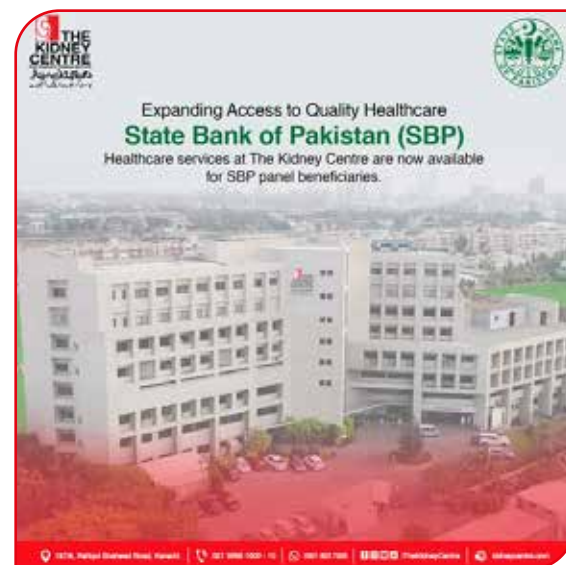


NATIONAL REFINERY LIMITED (NRL) EMPANELMENT

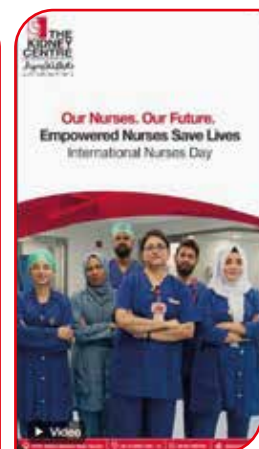
INTERNATIONAL NURSES DAY 2026

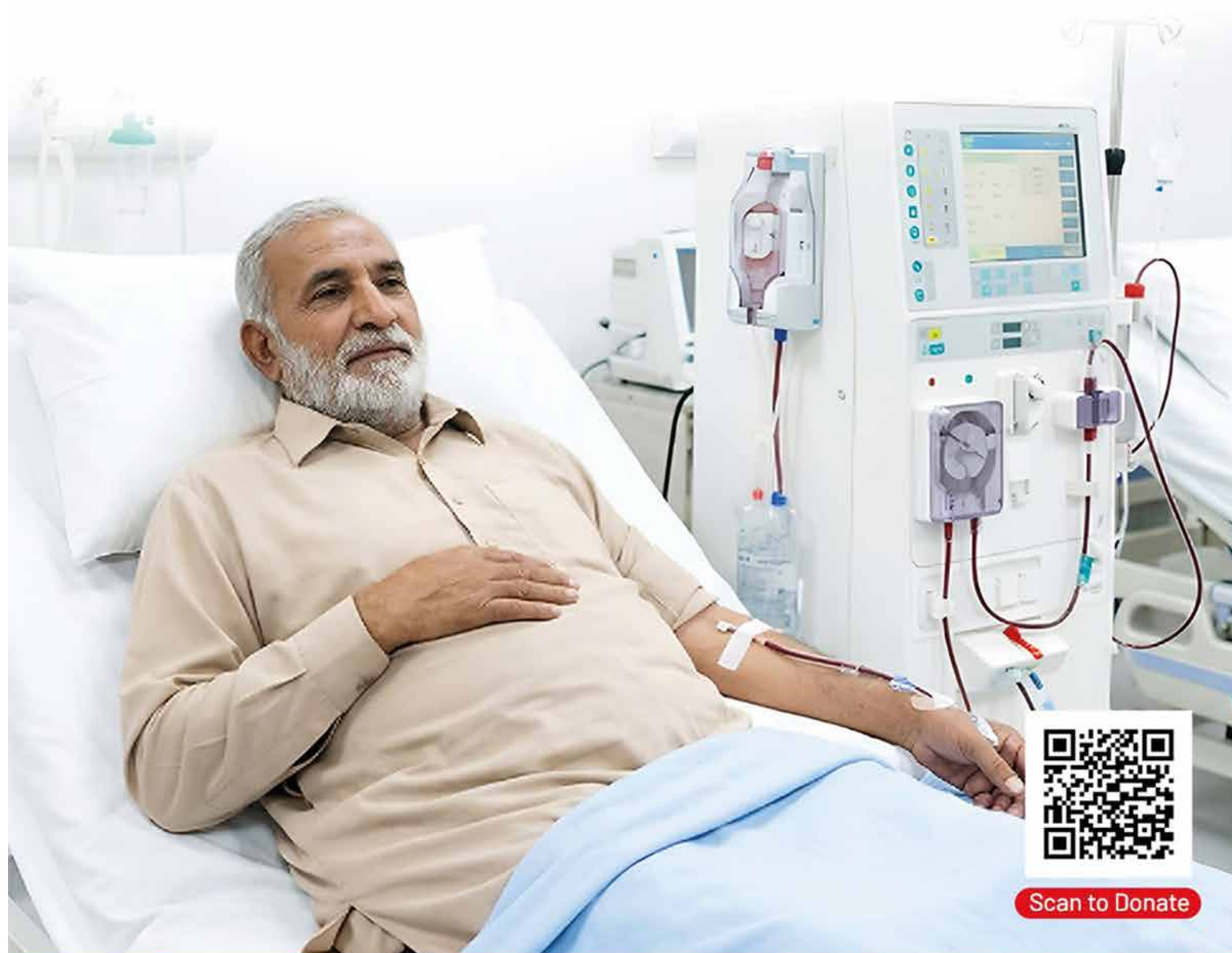
